WHEREAS, on December 1, 2011, the Town Board held a public hearing to consider applications to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for grants to fund certain projects at the East Hampton Town Airport , such projects consisting of the design of updated perimeter deer fencing at the Town Airport, and the installation of such perimeter deer fencing in accordance with the plans and specifications to be prepared; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board heard comments from numerous individuals, both for and against the Town's proposal to make applications to the FAA for grant funding of the aforementioned projects; and

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2011, the Town Board closed the public hearing with regard to the application for a grant to fund the design of the updated perimeter fencing, but left the hearing open on whether to apply for FAA grant funding for the installation of such perimeter deer fencing open until such time as, if approved, design work for the fence is completed and the public, upon further notice, has the opportunity to review and comment upon the same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 75-52 of the East Hampton Town Code, paragraph "B", the Town Board must ascertain whether the proposed grant application is in conformity with the current airport master plan or plan update and the current airport layout plan or plan update; and

WHEREAS, the planning of a project is a Type II action under the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) and chapter 128 (Environmental Quality Review) of the Town Code, and no further environmental review is needed with regard to the same; now, therefore, be it


RESOLVED, that the Town Board, after considering all of the comments presented at the Town Board's hearing on December 1, 2011 to consider the application for a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to design updated perimeter deer fencing at the Town Airport, hereby determines that such application is in conformity with the current airport master plan or plan update and the current airport layout plan or plan update; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Supervisor is hereby authorized to make application to the FAA for funding of the design of updated perimeter fencing at the East Hampton Town Airport; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Supervisor is hereby authorized to execute a grant application and agreement with the FAA upon such terms and conditions as the FAA shall stipulate for the funding of the design of the updated perimeter fencing at the East Hampton Town Airport; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Airport Engineers, DY Consultants, are authorized to commence design work upon the updated perimeter deer fencing upon approval of a grant agreement with the FAA.
